Fill the ball with kibbles and watch your cat roll it around to dispense food

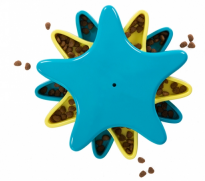

STARMARK BOB-A-LOT

The Bob-A-Lot is an easy-to-load treat and kibble dispenser. Simply unscrew the yellow top, add kibble, and adjust the dispensing window.

Your cat knocks the dispenser around and picks up the kibble that fall out.

DOC AND PHOEBE'S INDOOR HUNTING FEEDER

Stuff the mice with kibbles and allow your cat to "hunt"

DIY interactive cat feeder

Make your own feeder at home with some small containers, paper towel and/or toilet paper tubes

Use hot glue to attach them to a board or large piece of cardboard

Place kibbles inside for your cat to "puzzle" out



TRIXIE ACTIVITY

- Game 1: globe resembles a fish bowl and requires cats to scoop out treats with their paw
- Game 2: peg allows cats to make out treats from a distance and map out a hunting strategy
- Game 3: alley is a playful option that allows cats to earn treats while lying down using their paws or claws or toes
- Game 4: tongue is for liquid treats since the slits hinder the cat from using its paws
- Game 5: tunnel has a mouse hole for hiding toys and treats
